

Horse Registration - Reminder

Riders, members and horse owners are reminded of the requirements for registration of all endurance horses. Rule H 6.4 of the AERA Members Handbook states that an endurance horse can only enter an affiliated endurance ride if it has a current AERA registration label in its logbook.

It is the owner/rider's responsibility to ensure that the horse is registered and is presented to rides with a current registration label.

Presenting an unregistered horse at an endurance ride may result in the entry be rejected and the horse prevented from competing. If a horse is discovered to be unregistered after participating in a ride, the horse and rider may face disqualification.

Horses may be life time registered, which removes the necessity of registering the horse each year, but where owners/riders elect to take out annual registration this should be renewed in sufficient time for the registration label to be forwarded prior to attending a ride.

The requirement for registration does not apply to novice horses but becomes applicable once their status changes from novice to endurance horse.
